# 1. Organ donor in hospital

Consent is granted for organ donation

# 2. Hospital checks organs

Medical experts assess which organs can be donated (heart, lung, liver, pancreas, kidney, intestine)

### 3. Hospital registers donor at Eurotransplant

A laboratory determines the donor's blood group and tissue characteristics and the medical data is sent to Eurotransplant

# 4. Matching at Eurotransplant

Data from the donor organ(s) matched with patients on the waiting list

# 5. Allocation of organs

Eurotransplant offers donor organ(s) to transplant center(s)

### 6. Acceptance of organs

Transplant center evaluates organ offer and accepts (or declines)

# 7. Recovery of organ(s)

Surgery is performed on the donor

# 8. Transportation of organs

The organs are transported from donor hospital to transplant center by the fastest means possible


# 9. Transplantation of organ(s)

Surgery is performed on the recipient

### 10. Follow-up

Recipient receives regular checkups at the transplant center following transplantation


The data gathered during organ donations and transplantations together with recipient's follow-up data helps Eurotransplant to improve the allocation


